The Command to Love

(1) Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us (given to us), that we should be called children of God (and so we are)! Therefore, the world does not know us, (and the reason is) because it did not know Him.

III. 1 Cor 13:8-13 Paul tells us that Biblical love is greater than all the spiritual gifts.
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In 1 Corinthians chapter 13 Paul describes Biblical love in terms of <u>action words</u> .
" let us not love in word or in tongue, but in deed and in truth." 1 John 3:18

Love is willing to want the best for others, and refuses to color things against others. Love does not rejoice in unrighteousness. Love is never glad when things go wrong. Love doesn't gloat over someone that isn't liked who falls into sin. This kind of love seeks to avoid involvement in evil and helps others steer clear of evil, too. Love sensitively confronts and corrects. Love cares deeply and guards against sin because it knows that sin destroys.

ANSWERS TO LESSON 7
5a Love does not behave rudely (it does not dishonor others or does not act unbecomingly)
DEFINE Dishonor disgrace, shame, humiliate, debase, lower, cheapen, discredit, drag down, smear, embarrass
DEFINE Unbecomingly <u>not appropriate</u> , <u>attractive</u> , <u>or flattering</u> , <u>not in accord with the standards implied by one's character or position (conduct unbecoming an officer).</u>
Prov 15:4 A wholesome tongue is a tree of life, But perverseness in it breaks the spirit
5b Love does not seek its own (not self-seeking)
DEFINE Self-seeking <u>having concern for one's own welfare and interests before those of others; self-serving. self-absorbed, self-regarding, wrapped up in oneself, egotistical, selfish, inconsiderate, thoughtless, uncaring, looking after number one, concern for oneself before others, the act or practice of selfishly advancing one's own ends, seeking only to further one's own interests</u>
Rom 12:10 giving preference to one another
Phil 2:3 <u>Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself.</u>
5c Love is not provoked (is not easily angered)
DEFINE Anger <u>a strong feeling of annoyance, displeasure, hostility, irration, resentment, wrath</u> .
Ecc 7:9 Do not hasten in your spirit to be angry, For anger rests in the bosom of fools.
5d Love thinks no evil (keeps no record of wrongs)
DEFINE evil profoundly immoral, wicked, wrong.
Prov 17:9 <u>He who covers a transgression seeks love</u>
